Member participation numbers for Career Development Events at Sub-states and State Convention from the past few years were reviewed by the members of the committee. The committee saw no advantage of moving any of the CDEs from Districts and Sub-states, to States only. The largest participant numbers were in Job Interview and Extemporaneous Speaking. Concerns the committee discussed included the numbers participating in sub-state CDEs, time required for the number of participants, judges for sub-states, providing opportunities for members, and ways to hold CDEs in other formats.

The CDE participation committee recommends allowing the top four placing individuals or teams at districts to move on to sub-states if deemed qualified by the judges.

The committee also recommends that local chapters and sub-districts be encouraged to hold local, sub-district, and open competitions to allow more participation opportunities for FFA members.
